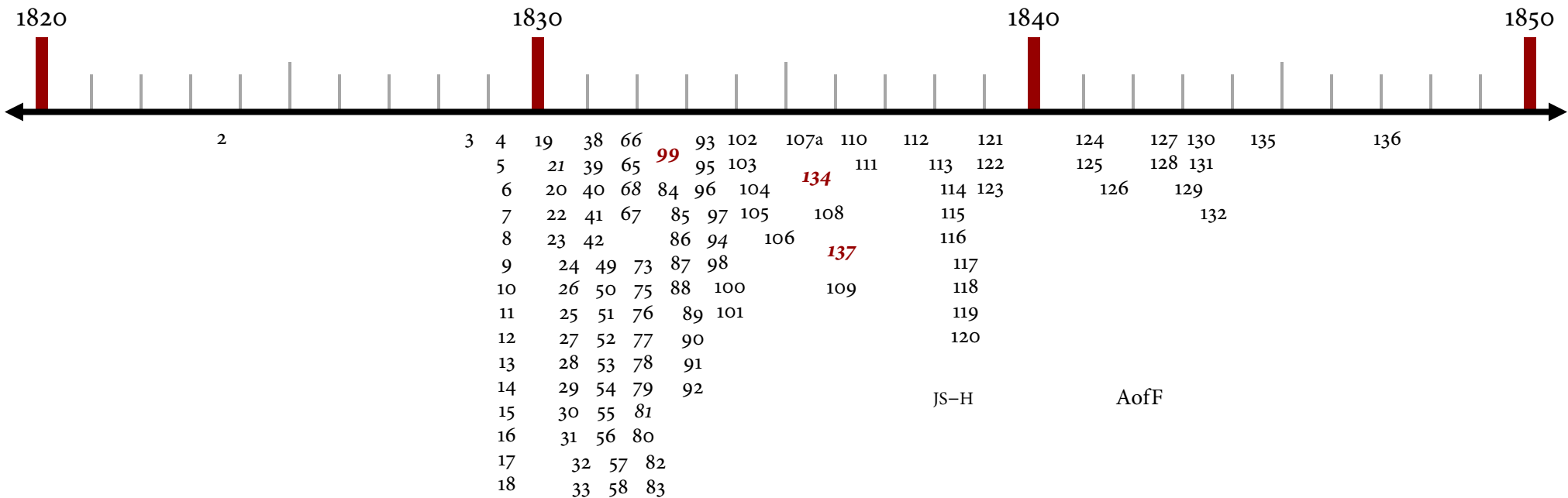

## TIMELINE OF REVELATIONS

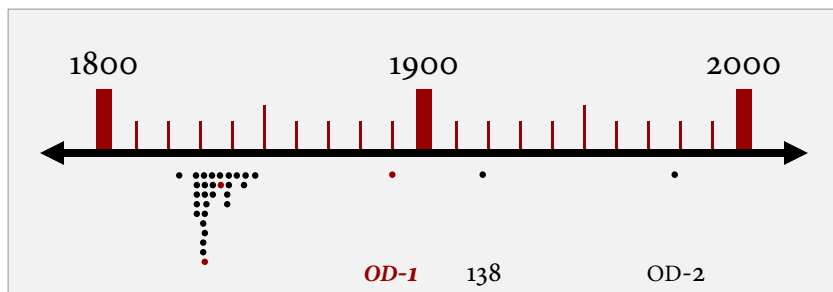
### Doctrine and Covenants 1–137

This timeline depicts the date each section of the Doctrine and Covenants was received. Section 138 and Official Declarations 1–2 are not included because they came at a much later time than the sections depicted here (cf. smaller timeline).

The sections of the Doctrine and Covenants are for the most part numbered in chronological order, but there are a few exceptions. Major exceptions (those numbered more than a year out of place) have bold-italic numbers. Minor exceptions (all numbered less than three months out of place) have non-bold italic numbers.

The date for Joseph Smith—History reflects the time of publication, not the time period narrated in the text.

# CHRONOLOGICAL READING DIAGRAM

## The Doctrine and Covenants, Joseph Smith—History, and the Articles of Faith

The purpose of a chronological reading diagram is to enable people to read the scriptures in chronological order, even when doing so requires jumping back and forth between passages or even between different books of scripture.

This diagram shows the relationship between the Doctrine and Covenants, Joseph Smith—History, and the Articles of Faith. By beginning at the top and following the arrows between books, one can read the entire content of all three books, in roughly the chronological sequence in which the events and revelations occurred.

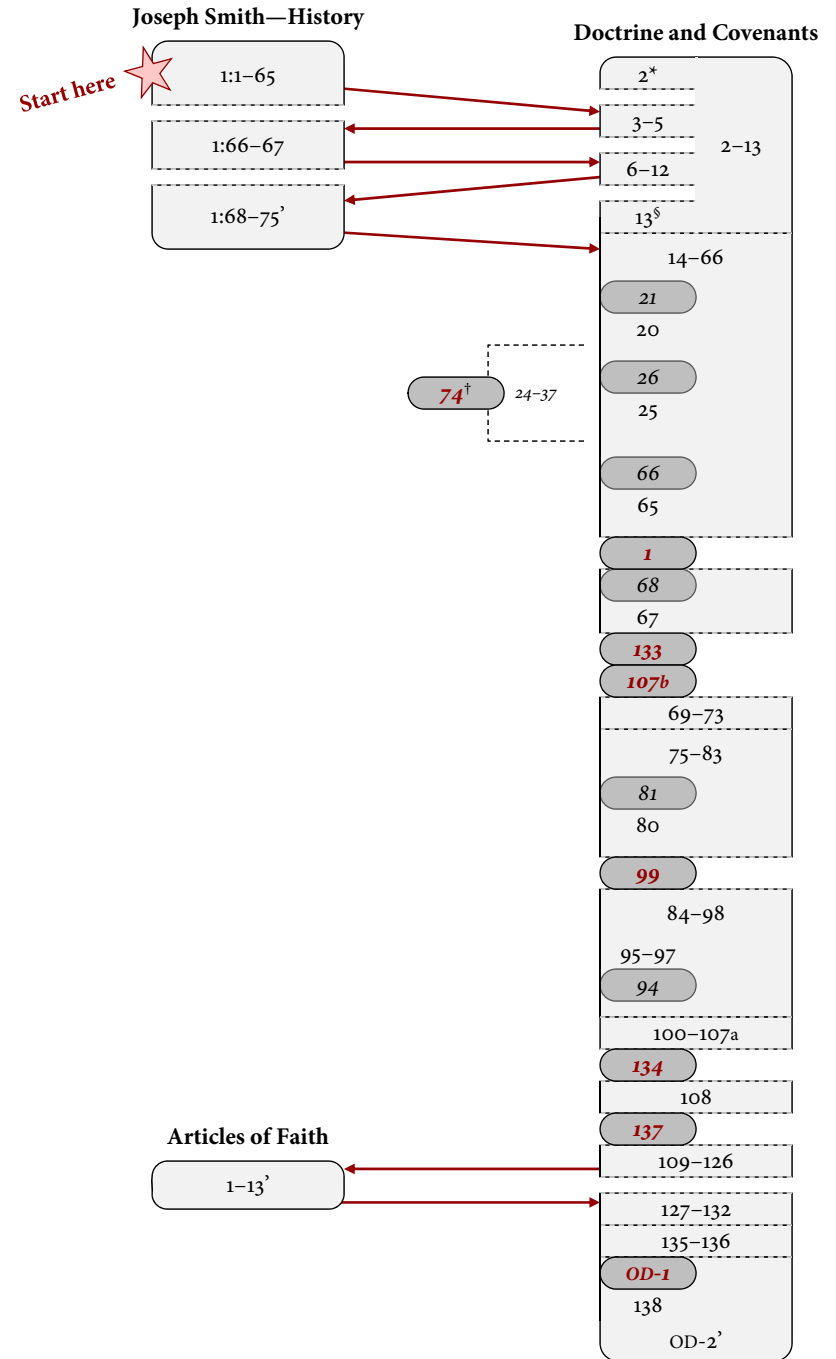
The sections of the Doctrine and Covenants are for the most part numbered in chronological order, but there are a few exceptions. Those exceptions have italicized numbers and are in shaded capsules; they are the ones which must be read out of numerical sequence in order to be read in chronological order. Of these shaded sections, major exceptions (those numbered more than a year out of place) have bold-italic numbers. The rest are minor exceptions (all numbered less than three months out of place) and have non-bold italic numbers; they usually only need to be swapped with an adjacent section to be in the right sequence.
