E.g., These two weeks of reading passages ... are taught on this Sunday.

Grey and white bands show which weeks' passages will be covered together in the corresponding Sunday school class (the dark grey Sunday that falls within the same band). I.e., each Sunday school class session, the teacher covers all the reading passages that have been read since the previous session.

Dark grey Sundays are the times when Sunday school classes will be held (i.e., every first and third Sunday of each month).

*While chapters from *Saints* are not listed in the CFM manual, they are included here for readers who wish to read them in tandem with the D&C schedule, to provide context for each week's sections. Read the week's *Saints* chapter(s) first, then the D&C passages.
