

Yellow-shaded chapter numbers are chronological digressions from the main story timeline—usually flashbacks to an earlier time period, but also editorial summaries inserted during a later time period (title page, Words of Mormon). Green-shaded chapter numbers are extensive quotations from earlier prophets, usually from the Old Testament.

The major and minor subdivisions of the books on this chart are based in part on the StoryGuide edition of the Book of Mormon.
